Prior to every volunteer project, RTSEM vets each homeowner, conducts a site inspection with a 25-point health and safety checklist, develops a scope of work, purchases all materials, covers each volunteer on our insurance policy, and provides project leadership.

We ask each team to provide breakfast, lunch, and snacks for their volunteers so that all funding can go toward the homeowners in need. We ask each team to provide a House Captain who will attend RTSEM's House Captain training in February and work with RTSEM Program Manager to manage volunteers and scope on workday.
